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Seeking Residential Care?

It is hard to make the decision to move a loved one into residential care when they are no longer able to live a comfortable life independently. Let us help you access the right type of residential care they need – whether it be permanent residential care or short term respite care.

How you can access Residential Care

ACAT Assessment To be eligible to receive Commonwealth funding toward the cost of your stay you will need to be approved as a recipient of Residential Aged Care by the regional ACAT (Aged Care Assessment Team). This assessment is free of charge and your ACAT approval is valid for 12 months from the date of initial approval.

Important details to provide Before we can settle you into residential respite care, the Care Team will require the following information:

- a copy of your ACAT assessment
- your Pension/DVA and Medicare cards
- contact details the residents' next of kin /guardian/carer and power of attorney
- contact details of the residents' GP
- a list of all prescriptions, medications, known allergies and any special equipment required to care for the residents' needs.

Fees and Charges Our Care Team will be happy to discuss details of fees and charges at the time of enquiry. These are regulated by the Commonwealth Department of Health. Fees are payable at the time of admission. The amount a resident pays for their care and accommodation depends on their means assessment. Respite Care entitlements

You are entitled to 62 days (in total) of funded respite care per annum. Respite accommodation at the Centre is dependent on bed availability and is not usually available for less than a 2 week period. A Respite Care Agreement will be signed by the resident (or their next of kin/guardian/carer).
