Moving In

Step 1 – Obtain an Aged Care Assessment

To move to Gallipoli Home, you will need to consult with and be assessed by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) in order to establish the level of care required. To arrange for a health professional to visit and complete the assessment, call ACAT directly on 1800 200 422.

Step 2 – Assets & Income Test

The Federal Government subsidises the cost of residential aged care, but residents also pay fees and charges, depending on their income and assets. To access subsidised care, you will need to have an income and assets assessment done by Centrelink.

We strongly encourage you to obtain independent professional advice on the options most advantageous to your financial wellbeing.
