Metrobus M60 service operates regular services from Hornsby to Castle Hill.

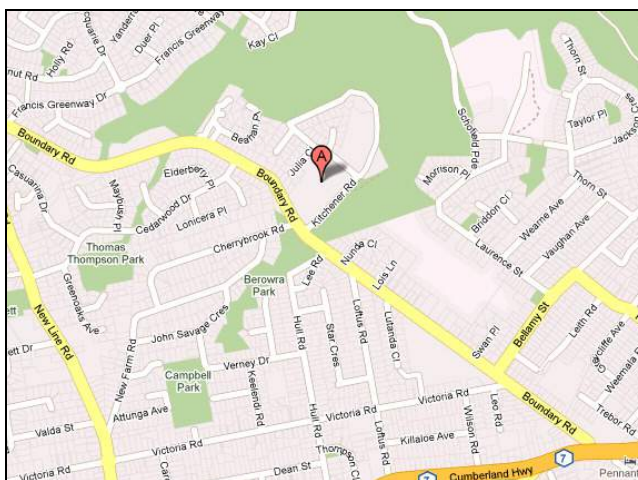

About Cherrybrook Christian Care Centre

Cherrybrook Christian Care Centre is a 120 bed facility for both high and low care residents, including those living with dementia. Set within the grounds of Elouera Gardens Christian Retirement Village, the Centre overlooks picturesque Elouera Reserve. It also boasts lovely flower filled courtyards where residents can relax or entertain friends and family.

The centre consists of 3 wings including a secure dementia unit for both high and low care residents. Registered nurses are employed to provide 24 hour supervision in the centre. Although most residents have single rooms with ensuites, some of our high care specific rooms cater for 2 residents with shared facilities.

Our centre has an excellent reputation for promoting ageing in place, providing residents and families with peace of mind for continual care. The Facility Manager is supported by a Clinical Care Coordinator and a team of very experienced care staff, therapists, maintenance and domestic staff who go that extra mile to enhance the lives of our residents. A team of volunteers also helps to provide that extra care we like to give.

We also provide low care respite care for residents needing short break accommodation.



Services

Included, but not limited to:

- As a resident of the Facility you may like to have your own doctor, provided he/she elects to visit the Facility. If this is not possible, the Facility Manager will discuss a suitable alternative with you and advise you on selecting another doctor.
- Physiotherapists visit the Facility regularly to assist with additional care requirements.
- Podiatry is available onsite by appointment.
- Diversional Therapy program 5 days per week with various activities catering to the liking of everyone.
- Musical activities and bus outings.
- Hairdressing salon.
- Laundry service and clothes labelling.
- Meals prepared fresh daily in our fully appointed kitchen.
- There are no set visiting hours at Cherrybrook Christian Care Centre. We encourage relatives and friends to visit throughout the day and evening. Guests are always welcome to attend a meal in the dining area with the residents (a small fee is payable for meals).
- Resident and Relatives meetings are held every three months. This is an opportunity to express any concerns you may have. It is also a way of keeping you informed of any changes or new initiatives within the Facility.
- Regular Church Services are held.
