

*Warnervale Gardens is a residential aged care home, providing accommodation for 66 residents with varying care needs, specialising in dementia and respite care, with provision for married couples.*



Operating since 2005, the home has gained an excellent reputation in the local community for the quality of care it provides.

Warnervale Gardens is fully certified and accredited with the Department of Social Services and the Australian Aged Care Quality Agency. Additionally, the home was awarded two Better Practice Awards in 2011 for the implementation of the Memory Magic Program and the Cameos for Empathy in Dementia Care project.

The home employs approximately 43 staff including the residential care manager, registered nurses, enrolled nurses, care assistants, lifestyle & wellbeing and hotel services staff. Additionally, Anglican Care employs

a Lifestyle & Wellbeing Co-ordinator who works across all of our residential aged care homes. Allied health services including physiotherapy are organised as required. Warnervale Gardens has a visiting podiatrist, together with a hairdresser who visits on a weekly basis.

Unique to each of Anglican Care's residential aged care homes is the role of the Resident Liaison Officer. The objective of this role is to ensure that the individual and social wellbeing needs of our residents are met according to Anglican Care's values. The Resident Liaison Officers also act as a liaison for residents and relatives with due regard to the Charter of Residents Rights and Responsibilities.



The quality of care provided at Warnervale Gardens is enhanced by the provision of a stimulating lifestyle and wellbeing program. Anglican Care also has an active community of volunteers, with many volunteers providing additional services and new friendships to the residents of Warnervale Gardens.

All of Anglican Care's residential aged care homes provide our residents with the services of a qualified Chaplain to offer spiritual and emotional support, as well as weekly on-site church services. Our Chaplains offer person-centred pastoral care which affirms the intrinsic dignity and worth of each individual.



Warnervale Gardens is an architecturally designed service which includes many communal areas where residents can enjoy the company of other residents, family and friends, participate in group activities and concerts, or enjoy some quality 'alone-time'. The home is known for its wide corridors, high ceilings and natural lighting with the entry consisting of a spacious reception area. Branching out from this area is direct access to Warnervale Garden's Residential Care Manager, Registered Nurses, Resident Liaison Officer and Clerical staff, together with a library and hairdressing salon. Central to the home is the main lounge where many concerts and group activities are held. This area also includes a coffee machine. The home has four wings, with

each wing including a central lounge, kitchennette and dining area together with two smaller lounge areas. Each of the four wings also has access to a lovely courtyard with shaded seating areas, gardens and walking paths. Additional features of the home include two other activity areas together with a dedicated chapel.

Located within the Lakes Anglican Parish area, the home is located in the fast growing suburb of Woongarra. The location was chosen due to the closeness of facilities such as hospitals, shopping centres and rail links, all within two to three kilometres of the home. Warnervale Gardens enjoys close ties with the local GPs, schools and other community groups.
