

*Storm Village is a residential aged care home providing accommodation for 117 residents of varying levels of care needs, including general, dementia specific and respite care.*



Enjoying a long history in the Taree area, the home is well known in the local community for the quality of care it provides and is fully certified and accredited with the Department of Social Services and the Australian Aged Care Quality Agency.

The home employs approximately 100 staff including the residential care manager, 24/7 registered nurses, enrolled nurses, care assistants, lifestyle & wellbeing, hotel services staff, clerical and maintenance staff. Additionally, Anglican Care employs a

Lifestyle and Wellbeing Coordinator who works across all of our residential aged care homes. Unique to each of Anglican Care's residential aged care homes is the role of the Resident Liaison Officer. The objective of this role is to ensure that the individual and social wellbeing needs of our residents are met according to Anglican Care's values. The Resident Liaison Officers also act as a liaison for residents and relatives with due regard to the Charter of Residents Rights and Responsibilities.



The quality of care provided at Storm Village is enhanced by the provision of a stimulating lifestyle and wellbeing program. Anglican Care also has an active community of volunteers, with many volunteers providing additional services and new friendships to the residents at Storm Village.

All of Anglican Care's residential aged care homes provide our residents with the services of a qualified Chaplain to offer spiritual and emotional support, as well as weekly on-site church services. Our Chaplains offer person-centred pastoral care which affirms the intrinsic dignity and worth of each individual.



Storm Village is a very spacious and diverse home with many communal areas that residents are able to access and enjoy. Entry to Storm Village is via a large and welcoming foyer area. Situated throughout the home are an assortment of sitting rooms, spacious lounge and dining areas and large activity areas. These areas provide places where residents can enjoy the company of family and friends, spend some quality 'alone-time' and spiritual reflection and enjoy group activities.

Other communal features of Storm Village include: stunning gardens and walkways, including sensory gardens, raised garden beds, water features and an onsite dam; pergolas and other undercover outdoor areas, including BBQ areas, and al fresco dining areas;

a large conference room which is used for group functions and activities; both an onsite Chapel and an internal Chapel with beautiful stained glass windows; laundry facilities for residents who wish to do their own personal laundry; a dedicated library; two hairdressing salons; two physiotherapy and wellness rooms.

Located within the Taree Anglican Community, the facility is approximately 15 minutes from both Manning Rural Referral Hospital and Mayo Private Hospital and enjoys close ties with the local GPs, schools and other community groups.

Also located on the Taree site are the Administration Office, Chapel and 18 retirement living units.
