We care by providing a residential services in-reach program. In-reach works closely with residents, their GPs and staff to provide care within the nursing home as an alternative to admission to hospital when a resident becomes unwell.

If the resident's condition does require hospitalisation, the program's registered nurses support the resident in their return to their aged care home.

The in-reach program is an integral part of Ballarat Health Services providing effective, high quality care to residents.

We care by providing access to rehabilitation services, with programs aimed at maintaining or restoring your physical well-being.

As part of Ballarat Health Services, we care by providing our residential aged care staff with a range of education opportunities, quality management and clinical governance initiatives that only a multi-faceted health care organisation like Ballarat Health Services can offer.
