## For quality care around the clock

Our care is nursing-led, meaning that our care caters for the broad range of changing, sometimes complex health needs of our residents. We provide assistance from the most basic supervision right through to the full provision of expert intensive aged care for every aspect of daily living.

Our residents receive attentive and quality clinical care:

- Registered Nurses provide care on site 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Our homes are managed by senior Registered Nurses, bringing years of aged healthcare experience into day-to-day care practices
- We employ experienced Registered Nurses as Unit Managers for a specific group of residents, providing a senior staff member as a consistent contact point for both residents and their families.

## Sharing interests and daily life

We understand that the routines of daily life are very important and focus on providing a comfortable and vibrant environment for our residents.

Our chefs work with dietitians and nutritionists to create tasty, healthy menus that support wellbeing. We work with residents to cater for specific cultural or health related dietary requirements.
