Care Management

The government sets aside 10% of your Support at Home funding specifically for Care Management. This supports you behind the scenes – planning your services, coordinating your team, keeping your care on track, and adjusting it as your needs or goals change.

You don't pay a co-contribution for Care Management.

At Harwell, you'll always have a dedicated Care Manager who knows you, checks in regularly and advocates for your needs ensuring your care is personal, proactive and seamless.

Budgeting to your Individual Support Plan

Everyone's needs and budgets are different and so are services available in each community. We work alongside you to plan support that feels right for you, and we connect you with trusted providers in your area who offer quality, value and care that aligns with your goals.

Co-Contributions

If you completed your My Aged Care assessment on or after 12 September 2024, the government may ask you to contribute to the cost of some services.

Services Australia determines your contribution based on your income and assets – not Harwell. We'll always explain your options and help you understand what it means for you.

Your contribution depends on the type of support:

Clinical Support (No contribution)

The government fully funds clinical care like nursing and physiotherapy.

- 0% contribution for all eligible older Australians

Independence Services (Moderate contribution)

Supports that help you stay independent – such as personal care, exercise support or equipment.

- Full pensioners: 5%
- Part pensioners: 5–50% (means-tested)
- Self-funded retirees: 50%

Everyday Living (Higher contribution)

Day-to-day services like cleaning, gardening and meals.

- Full pensioners: 17.5%
- Part pensioners: 17.5–80% (means-tested)
- Self-funded retirees: 80%

We'll walk you through your options and help you feel confident in your plan, every step of the way.

How We Charge

- All prices listed are average hourly rates unless noted otherwise
- Services are charged in 15-minute increments and only for the time you receive, with minimum visit time of 30 mins for Clinical and Independence services. Everyday Living services have a minimum visit of 2 hours, however this can be for multiple services such a general cleaning, laundry and meal preparation.
- Some clinical services include extra time for assessments and documentation
- Transport and group programs vary depending on your needs and choices, we'll confirm costs with you before you start

At Harwell, transparency matters. You'll always know what you're paying for, and you'll never be surprised by a bill.

Cancellations

To help us run reliable services for all clients, cancellations with less than 2 business days' notice may be charged. You may also be charged if we arrive and you are not home at the arranged time, or our services are turned away upon arrival.
