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# Support at Home Pricing Schedule

Effective 01/11/2025

## Wiluna Aged Care Service Delivery and Pricing

This schedule provides information on the price for common services you can access from Wiluna Aged Care Service through your Support at Home package. The costs are deducted each month for your overall Support at Home budget. All services are delivered GST free except purchases of equipment on your behalf which will include the cost of GST on the goods purchased. This schedule aligns with the Australian Government's Support at Home Program (effective 1 November 2025) and outlines Wiluna Aged Care Service's pricing structure for ongoing support services

Under Support at Home, participants may be asked to pay a **means-tested contribution** toward their care, depending on their income and assets.

The amounts shown below are the approximate amount allocated by the Australian Government for care each year for the allocated Support at Home level, which is paid monthly in arrears to Wiluna Aged Care Service.

Quarterly budgets are paid in arrears and reviewed annually in line with indexation by the Independent Health and Aged Care Pricing Authority (IHACPA).

### Care Management fees:

Up to 10% of the participant's quarterly budget may be used for care management, depending on their assessed care coordination needs.

### \*Short-term/special pathways:

Short-term pathways operate independently of ongoing classifications and are time-limited (up to 12 weeks). Eligibility is determined by the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT).

Pathway / Classification Purpose / Focus	Indicative Funding / Scope
<b>Restorative Care Pathway</b>	Short-term, goal-oriented care to maintain or regain function / independence (e.g. after illness or hospital stay). ~ \$6,000 over 12 weeks; may be increased to ~ \$12,000 when eligible.
<b>End-of-Life Pathway</b>	Support for older people with ~3 months or less to live, who wish to remain at home. ~ \$25,000 over 12 weeks.

### Charges for individual services

The Support at Home Program does not allow for the purchase of food, except as part of enteral feeding (tube in the nose to help with feeding). The Support at Home can pay for the cost of staff buying the food, cooking the food, and delivering the food, but the client **must** pay for the cost of the food itself. A direct deduction arrangement is set up with Centrelink to automatically deduct this contribution from clients who request the meal service.

Unspent funds may be carried over **up to \$1,000 or 10% of the quarterly budget**, whichever is higher. Any unspent funds above this limit will be returned to the participant's next quarterly allocation.
