Dining with us

Our team of chefs and food services specialists are passionate and love cooking food that is enjoyed by all.

The team has developed a 28-day cycle menu based on a comprehensive resident survey and audit. This menu changes seasonally to ensure residents' likes and dislikes are met.

Our menu choices



The daily menu consists of two hot choices at lunch and a hot dinner, along with a section of alternative options, sides and desserts.



Residents are also offered a range of fruit, biscuits and cakes at morning, afternoon tea and supper.



Daily we offer a Continental Breakfast where residents can help themselves. As some of our residents enjoy a sleep in so our breakfast menu has been designed to offer flexibility and choice.

How is our food cooked?

Our team of chefs work in our purpose-built main kitchen based at Tarcoola Shepparton, and meals are transported to sites for heating and preparation before served to residents. We use a Cook Chill Food System which requires a high level of expertise to obtain the optimum meal quality. All food is prepared, cooked and chilled by us in accordance with the requirements of the Food Act 1984 and is audited annually by a qualified external Food Safety Auditor.

Celebrations

We celebrate special events such as birthdays, Australian Day, St Patrick's Day and much more with food appropriate for the occasion. It's always a hit!

Special diets

If you require a special diet, don't worry! Our aged care specialist chefs and cooks will be able to meet your needs. We have a special section in our main kitchen where texture modified meals and/or special meals that residents require are prepared.
