Beaufort Nursing Home is a 15-bed facility that is suitable for residents with higher care needs and is situated within the Beaufort & Skipton Health Campus in the rural township of Beaufort.

Beaufort Nursing Home is comprised of a wing that is adjacent to acute care services and allied health care centre.

The facility undergone refurbishment, completed March 2021, providing fresh rooms and enhanced living spaces for residents.

Beaufort Nursing Home is comprised of a kitchenette, large dining room and lounge area. The lounge room has a flat screen TV and access to DVD players for residents use.

There is an active leisure and lifestyle program to assist residents to participate in areas of interest and meaning to them.

Rooms in Beaufort Nursing Home are a combination of single rooms and shared rooms. The rooms are easily accessible to a shared ensuite and bedrooms have built in wardrobes. Residents are encouraged to personalise their space with soft furnishings, photographs and mementos. All rooms have access to telephone lines and television antenna.

Registered nurses are on site twenty-four hours a day and residents can also access a range of allied health services including dietetics, podiatry and physiotherapy, other visiting services such as speech pathology and hairdressing can be arranged.

The facility is within easy walking distance to shops and has views to the public park.

We take the safety of residents as a high priority and rooms are equipped with overhead tracking to enable staff to move non-mobile residents safely. Residents are provided with electric and height adjustable beds. Sensor mats are provided as a safety measure for any residents who are assessed as at risk. A nurse call bell system is readily accessible from each resident's bedside, bathrooms and lounge areas.

Meals are prepared freshly on site and different diets can be catered for.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit, a daily payment, or a combination of both.

A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments
