

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Before accessing any government funded aged care services, you must have a My Aged Care assessment. This is completed by a member of the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT).

The assessment is normally organised through your doctor, another health professional or directly through My Aged Care. The assessor visits you at home or hospital to discuss the assessment with you and your family.

An aged care assessment:

- confirms your eligibility for entry into Commonwealth Funded Aged Care
- determines your care needs and what types of care and services you may be eligible for.

Having an ACAT assessment does not mean you have to enter a residential aged care facility, but not having one will delay the process should you need care.



OUR SERVICES

Nazareth House provides services tailored to meet the individual needs of residents.

Services include:

Nursing Care

A Registered Nurse is on site 24 hours a day.

Pastoral Care

A person-centred Pastoral Care service provides for the spiritual and religious care of the resident. The service provides quality holistic care and supports family, visitors and employees in times of need. Priests, Ministers or Pastors will be contacted at the request of residents or families.

Physiotherapy

Residents are assessed on entry by a Physiotherapist for pain, mobility and dexterity, and are reviewed regularly.

Hairdresser

An on-site hairdressing salon is available every Monday and Thursday.

Laundry

On site laundering of residents personal items is available on request.

Meals

All meals are cooked fresh on-site each day in the central kitchen. Residents are offered variety and choice with our seasonal menus, and residents are consulted regarding menu changes. We use the services of Dietitians and Nutritionists. Special diets are catered for.

Library

Our library is managed by volunteers and includes large print and talking books.

Chapel

Nazareth Care Wynnum has a beautiful on site Chapel for residents, families and visitors.

Activity Programs

All residents have an individualised social, spiritual and cultural Care Plan which includes special events and activity preferences.

Mass and Prayer Services

Catholic services are conducted daily and other denominations services are conducted on a regular basis in our heritage listed Chapel.

Social Areas

Nazareth House Wynnum provides a variety of conversation and social areas for residents, family and visitors including lounge rooms, television rooms, activity areas, courtyards, extensive verandas and gardens.

Podiatry

Residents are offered podiatry services on a regular basis.

Pharmacy

We use the services of a pharmacy which allows for timely, personalised service.

Shop

Volunteers operate a shop for residents.

Nazareth Care Wynnum provides residential care and services including spiritual, pastoral and emotional support for residents and their families, offered by the Sisters of Nazareth.

Daily Mass and other services are celebrated in the Chapel.

Residents of the Nazareth community have ready access to qualified staff who provide support and care tailored to meet individual needs.
