* Important Notes:

1. Budgets are set quarterly, not annually.
2. You may roll over up to \$1,000 or 10% of your quarterly budget.
3. Clinical supports are always free of charge.
4. Independence support services has a small personal contribution (5%-50%) depending on your financial means.
5. Everyday living requires a higher personal contribution (17.5%-80%) depending on your financial means.
6. If you were receiving a Home Care Package before September 2024, you are protected under the government's "No Worse Off" principle.

Other funding

Restorative Care Pathway

This pathway helps participants stay independent, reduce reliance on services, and continue activities they enjoy. It includes up to 12 weeks of short-term restorative care, access to allied health services, and assistive technology or home modifications if required.

End-of-Life Pathway

Designed for individuals in their final months of life, this pathway supports them to remain at home with comfort and dignity. It offers priority assessments, flexible short-term funding, and personalised care support.

Assistive Technology & Home Modifications (AT-HM) Scheme

Eligible participants can access home modifications and assistive technology that meet their assessed care needs.
