Pet Friendly


Furry and feathered friends of residents and staff are welcome at Orana and many of our retirees share their homes with pets.

Services are available through Government -funded Commonwealth Home Support Programmes (CHSP)*, Home Care Packages or as fee-for-service.


Our home care packages are flexible and can include:
