Overview

Marycrest and Lilian Cooper offer progressive care in a stimulating and caring environment. Elderly residents are cared for with respect and gentleness. Staff ensure residents feel at home, and families and friends are always welcomed. Conveniently located near Brisbane's Story Bridge, both offer residents stunning views overlooking the Brisbane River and city skyline.

Marycrest and Lilian Cooper are also collated with St Vincent's Private Hospital Brisbane, which is located in Kangaroo Point - an inner suburb of Brisbane. Marycrest occupies the first five levels of the facility and Lilian Cooper Nursing Home is located on the top floor.

Rooms

Marycrest rooms have single occupancy whereas Lilian Cooper rooms have either single, double or triple occupancy. Each room has quality vinyl flooring coverings, wall finishes, window coverings, a robe and bedside cabinet with adequate storage and an electric high low bed. Marycrest rooms have a private ensuite and most have air-conditioning. Lilian Cooper rooms have air conditioning and either a private or shared ensuite depending on whether the room is single or shared. All rooms are fitted with an individual TV point, telephone line access and general power outlets. Room views face north or south and overlook Kangaroo Point, the Brisbane River, the CBD skyline, the Story Bridge and New Farm.

Staffing

Marycrest and Lilian Cooper have a team of dedicated and skilled staff. The staff provide the best of nursing and personal care to promote health and wellbeing, prevent illness and disease and to relieve suffering and pain for those who are sick, frail or disabled.

Shared Facilities

All Residents have access to a recreation/lifestyle room, library/computer centre, hairdresser/beauty salon, lounge/movie room, outdoor sensory garden and Giovanni Chapel. Residents are also able to enjoy beautifully landscaped gardens which overlook the Brisbane River and CBD skyline.

Services

Marycrest and Lilian Cooper build relationships with residents based on mutual respect and trust. They provide services that cater for physical, social, and spiritual needs as well as supporting emotional wellbeing.

Activities

Marycrest and Lilian Cooper offer residents an extensive range of activities including; movies, bingo, pet therapy, cooking, craft, hoy, club outings, shopping trips, picnics, nail manicures, library group, sing-a-longs concerts, Italian, French and Spanish classes, sewing, choir, word games, book club, bowling, music therapy, happy hour and more. Individual therapy is also offered. Regular Mass is celebrated on site.

Nearby Amenities

Kangaroo Point is well known for its river and city views, the Kangaroo Point Cliffs and the famous Story Bridge. It has a number of holiday and residential towers given the close proximity of the area to the Brisbane CBD and has easy access to both the Gold and Sunshine Coasts.

History

Kangaroo Point is one of the earliest suburbs settled in Brisbane and subsequently, is rich in history and character. For many years the suburb was dominated by factories and stone was quarried from the cliffs for building material.

Hospitals

Both Marycrest and Lilian Cooper are collocated with St Vincent's Private Hospital Brisbane. In addition, it is conveniently located close to the Mater Adult and Private Hospitals (3km away), Princess Alexandra Hospital (4km away) and the Greenslopes Private Hospital (7km away).

Transport

Bus stop number 7 is located outside Marycrest and Lilian Cooper on Main Street. The ferry can be caught from the Holman Street wharf, the Thornton Street wharf or Dockside wharf. A courtesy phone for cabs is available in the reception of Marycrest. Buses also connect in the city at either Southbank or Queen Street. Transport information is available from Translink.

Shopping

Supermarkets and retail shops are located in Greenslopes, Stones Corner, Buranda and Woollongabba.

Recreation and Leisure

The Kangaroo Point Cliffs precinct is a popular area for walking with spectacular river and city views. Cinemas are located at Southbank and in the CBD. Just across the river is the Queensland Performing Arts Complex, the Queensland Art Gallery, the Queensland Museum, the Maritime Museum, the State Library and Southbank Parklands. Marycrest and Lilian Cooper are also close to Musgrave Park Pool which is 4.3km away.

Places of Worship

Mass is celebrated daily at Marycrest and Lilian Cooper in Giovanni Chapel. Other nearby places of worship includes the following churches: Catholic, Anglican, Uniting Church, Russian Orthodox, Lutheran, Ukrainian Byzantine, Serbian Orthodox and a Mormon Temple.
