



The Central and Upper Burnett District Home for the Aged is known to many people as Gunther Village. The land and building was donated by the Gunther family and it was through the efforts of many people within the communities of Biggenden, Gayndah, Mundubbera, Eidsvold and Monto, that made the building of the facility possible.

The community is still involved in the running of the home through a Board of Governance elected from the membership, which is open to any registered or previously registered elector in the North Burnett Regional Council area.

The organisation operates a 52-bed Residential Aged Care Facility which includes the provision of respite for short - term care.

Admission to this facility is open to any person with a current Aged Care Assessment; the fees are set by the Government and are income tested.

Additional services provided by the organisation include an onsite Coffee Shop, Broadband for Seniors iCafe, Community Cleaning & Support Services & "Elsebach Place". The BBQ area in the Gumnuts Playground is available for the use of family and friends.

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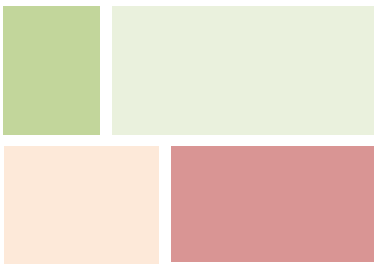

Care Services Provided

Residents care needs are assessed on admission by the Registered Nurse. With 24 hour nursing support, residents can be assured that calls for assistance are acted upon immediately. Our excellent support facilities, services and staff enable us to tailor an individual care plan in consultation with each resident, their family, doctor and health professionals.

Nursing staff can make arrangements for residents to have onsite appointments with a range of Health Providers including Doctors, Physiotherapists, Audiologists, Dieticians, Optometrists, Dental Technicians and Speech Pathologists. (A charge may apply for low care residents.)

The Care Team at Gunther Village is capably led and managed by a significant team of experienced and clinically qualified management and staff. This support team enables the organisation to deliver consistently high standards of care, compliance and quality systems' performance across the group.

Residents are encouraged to personalize their own rooms with soft furnishings & mementos.

Kitchen - The home has an on-site kitchen and all meals and snacks are provided. Residents are able to invite family and friends to join them for a meal if desired.

Laundry - The home has an on-site laundry to take care of the residents' personal clothing as well as the general laundry from the complex. Arrangements can be made for dry-cleaning to be attended if required.

Fees and Charges

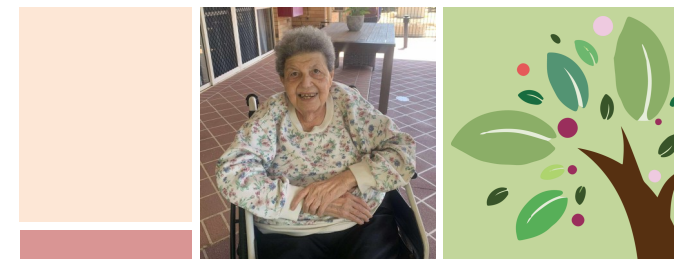
All fees and charges for the facility are income tested as per the Government guidelines and the level of approved care. If you would like further details of how to calculate the figure applicable to you please contact our office.



Assessing your Eligibility

To find out if you are eligible for residential aged care, you will need to be assessed by the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT). An ACAT assessment is a free assessment funded by the Australian Government. It is completed by a team of health professionals who provide information, advice and assistance to older people who are having difficulty living at home. The team will visit you at home or whilst you are in hospital to assess your lifestyle and healthcare needs, enabling them to determine the most appropriate care option for you. Residential care options vary and the ACAT assessment will provide a recommendation on the level of care required.
