Common areas

Café

Located on the ground floor, opens out to courtyard. Services include a fee.

Activities room / Chapel

Located on the ground floor with enough seating for church and large group events. A large screen television is available for movie nights.

Dining areas

Each wing has its own kitchen and dining area.

Lounge and sitting areas

Each wing has a large lounge area with flat screen television, and a secondary lounge area with books and magazines. Access to a courtyard or garden space from each common lounge area. Small sitting rooms are located at the end of each corridor.

Outdoor areas

Ground level has a large courtyard and access to gardens with benches and walking paths. Levels 1, 2 and 3 have balconies off each lounge area.

Hairdressing salon

Purpose-built salon located on the ground floor. A beauty therapist for manicures and pedicures is available once a week. Services include a fee.

Consulting and physiotherapy

Rooms are located on the ground floor.

Payment options

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable accommodation deposit (RAD), a daily accommodation payment (DAP), or a combination of both.

A RAD is paid as a lump sum amount. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example fortnightly.

A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum (RAD) and daily payments (DAP).

Where a resident doesn't pay the RAD in full, they can elect to have their DAP deducted from their deposit. Where this occurs, the amount of DAP will gradually increase as their deposit decreases. As the RAD deposit decreases, the resident may be required to make a further deposit if the deductions are to continue.
