Skipton Nursing Home is an 20-bed facility that is suitable for residents with higher care needs and is situated within the Beaufort & Skipton Health Campus at the rural township of Skipton.

The facility is comprised of two wings that are adjacent to acute care services, a medical practice and allied health care centre.

Each wing of Skipton Nursing Home is comprised of a kitchenette, large dining room and lounge area. The large lounge room has a flat screen TV and access to DVD players for residents use and has an outlook to the Skipton Lake.

There is an active leisure and lifestyle program to assist residents to participate in areas of interest and meaning to them.

All rooms in Skipton Nursing Home are single rooms with a garden view or rural outlook. They all contain a private ensuite and feature built in wardrobes. Residents are encouraged to personalise their space with soft furnishings, photographs and mementos. All rooms have access to telephone lines and television antenna.

Registered nurses are on site twenty-four hours a day. Residents can also access a range of allied health services including dietetics, podiatry and physiotherapy, other visiting services such as speech pathology and hairdressing.

Skipton Nursing Home is conveniently collocated with the medical practice, which means residents can access a General Practitioner who can easily visit residents on site.

The facility is surrounded by gardens, has an internal courtyard and private areas for reflection and for visitors to make use. We take the safety of residents as a high priority and rooms are equipped with overhead tracking to enable staff to move non-mobile residents safely. Residents are provided with electric height adjustable beds. Sensor mats can be provided, as a safety measure for any residents who are assessed as at risk. A nurse call bell system is readily accessible from each resident’s bedside, bathrooms and lounge areas.

Meals are prepared freshly on site and different diets can be catered for.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit, a daily payment, or a combination of both.  
 A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments
