Common areas

Café

Located in the lobby area, near the lounge with open fire. Services include a fee.

Activities room / Chapel

Located on the ground floor.
Equipped with audio-visual system.

Dining areas

Each area has its own kitchen and dining space. Large windows provide plenty of natural light. Accessible toilet with call button is close by.

Hairdressing salon

Purpose built salon on level 2.
Services include a fee.

Laundries

Laundry is done by staff at the on-site commercial laundry.
Each area has a fully-equipped laundry for resident use.

Lounge and sitting areas

Each area has its own lounge with large flat-screen TV, magazines, books, and smaller sitting areas.

Outdoor areas

Each area has several outdoor terrace areas with access to gardens and walking paths.

Physiotherapy

Located on the second floor.

One resident per room

Payment options

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable accommodation deposit (RAD), a daily accommodation payment (DAP), or a combination of both.

A RAD is paid as a lump sum amount. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example fortnightly.

A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum (RAD) and daily payments (DAP).

Where a resident doesn't pay the RAD in full, they can elect to have their DAP deducted from their deposit. Where this occurs, the amount of DAP will gradually increase as their deposit decreases. As the RAD deposit decreases, the resident may be required to make a further deposit if the deductions are to continue.
